

A MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF

Spring is right around the corner!

This means it is time for Spring Cleanup. The Reserve Township Police Department will begin to aggressively enforce violations of our Environmental Impact Ordinance #583. This is a reminder advising all residents to cleanup / remove any rubbish, litter, yard debris, branches, clippings, tires and other worthless trash from your property. Keep grass below (8) inches and cut /remove obnoxious vegetation. It is prohibited to keep / store any junk or abandoned vehicle on public or private property. An abandon or junk vehicle is defined as any vehicle that does not display a valid registration plate and valid inspection or has not been moved in (7) days.

With the arrival of nice weather, it is a sure thing the Police Department will be receiving calls about recreational fires. Reserve Township follows Allegheny County Health Department's Open Burn Regulations. No material other than clean wood, propane, or natural gas may be open burned EXCEPT for:

- o Commercially available fire logs, paraffin logs, or wood pellets;
- o Paper or commercial smokeless fire starters in order to start a fire;
- o Charcoal for the preparation of food only.

Fires may be no larger than 3' wide by 3' long by 2' high.

SPRING CLEANING TIME RIGHT AROUND THE CORNER

- * Please keep in mind the Townships Environmental Impact Ordinance #583, which prohibits the dumping of junk/abandon vehicles, tires other automotive parts, litter, other worthless trash, and yard debris, including grass clippings, shrubbery, and trees. An abandon or junk vehicle is defined as any vehicle that does not display a valid registration plat and valid inspection.
- * Fences, Sheds, Driveways, Walkways, or any special conditions <u>ALL</u> require Zoning Permits. Permit applications are available at the Township office. Any questions, contact the Zoning Officer at 412-322-1551.
- * Building Permits-Building Permits are required for the following: (List is NOT all inclusive & Zoning Permits may be required Please call for additional information)
 - 1. Any permanent structure such as a house, garage and additions to existing structures.
 - 2. Structural changes to roofs of existing structures including the raising of roofs or dormers.
 - 3. Changes to existing structures for interior partitions, bearing walls or beams.
 - 4. All storage sheds, play houses & outdoor shelters that exceed 120 sq. ft. fences over 4ft. in height and any concrete pads or patios along with decks for any structure including pools.
 - 5. Replacement of existing porches. Any type of enclosure to existing porches or patios.
 - 6. Window or door changes that involve the enlarging of the existing wall opening or the creation of a new opening.
 - 7. Installation of swimming pools, above ground or in-ground.
 - 8. New paving of driveways with the exception of the replacement of an existing driveway with the same material with no increase in the dimensions of the driveway.
 - 9. A demolition permit is required when razing any house or building.
 - 10. All excavating, backfill, dumping of fill or digging requires a grading permit.
 - 11. Any type of wall or retaining wall.

Residents of Reserve Township

During periods of high winds, please take an extra moment and make sure your recycling items and garbage containers are secure to prevent trash from blowing into neighbors' yards, roadways, wooded areas, etc. Use garbage cans with a tight lid. If it is windy the night before trash collection, attempt to place the garbage containers out the morning of pick up.
