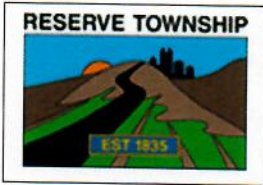
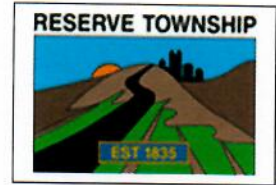

A MESSAGE FROM CHIEF JAMES ETHERINGTON

The Reserve Township Police Department will begin to aggressively enforce violations of our Environmental Impact Ordinance #583. This is a reminder advising all residents to cleanup / remove any rubbish, litter, yard debris, branches, clippings, tires and other worthless trash from your property. Keep grass below (8) inches and cut / remove obnoxious vegetation. It is prohibited to keep / store any junk or abandoned vehicle on public or private property. An abandon or junk vehicle is defined as any vehicle that does not display a valid registration plate and valid inspection or has not been moved in (7) days.

With the arrival of nice weather, it is a sure thing the Police Department will be receiving calls about recreational fires. Reserve Township follows Allegheny County Health Department's Open Burn Regulations. No material other than clean wood, propane or natural gas may be open burned EXCEPT for:

- o Commercially available fire logs, paraffin logs or wood pellets.
- o Paper or commercial smokeless fire starters in order to start a fire.
- o Charcoal for the preparation of food only.

Fires may be no larger than 3' wide by 3' long by 2' high.

The tremendous amount of litter scattered daily across Reserve Township roads is beyond disgraceful and very disrespectful. Our road department does their best to remove some of this trash, if their schedule and time permits. I do believe the residents of Reserve do their best to help pick up loose trash along their property. If you see anybody littering or throwing anything from their vehicle, please get the license plate and call police.

When walking your dog in our community, remember that it must be leashed. Also, it is important to remember to immediately clean up after your pet. Take along a baggie with you to pick up waste with and then dispose of it properly. For your convenience we have provided three (3) disposal stations throughout the township. You can find them on Pittview at Mt. Troy Rd. (Standard Bank), Prom Park and Spring Garden Park.

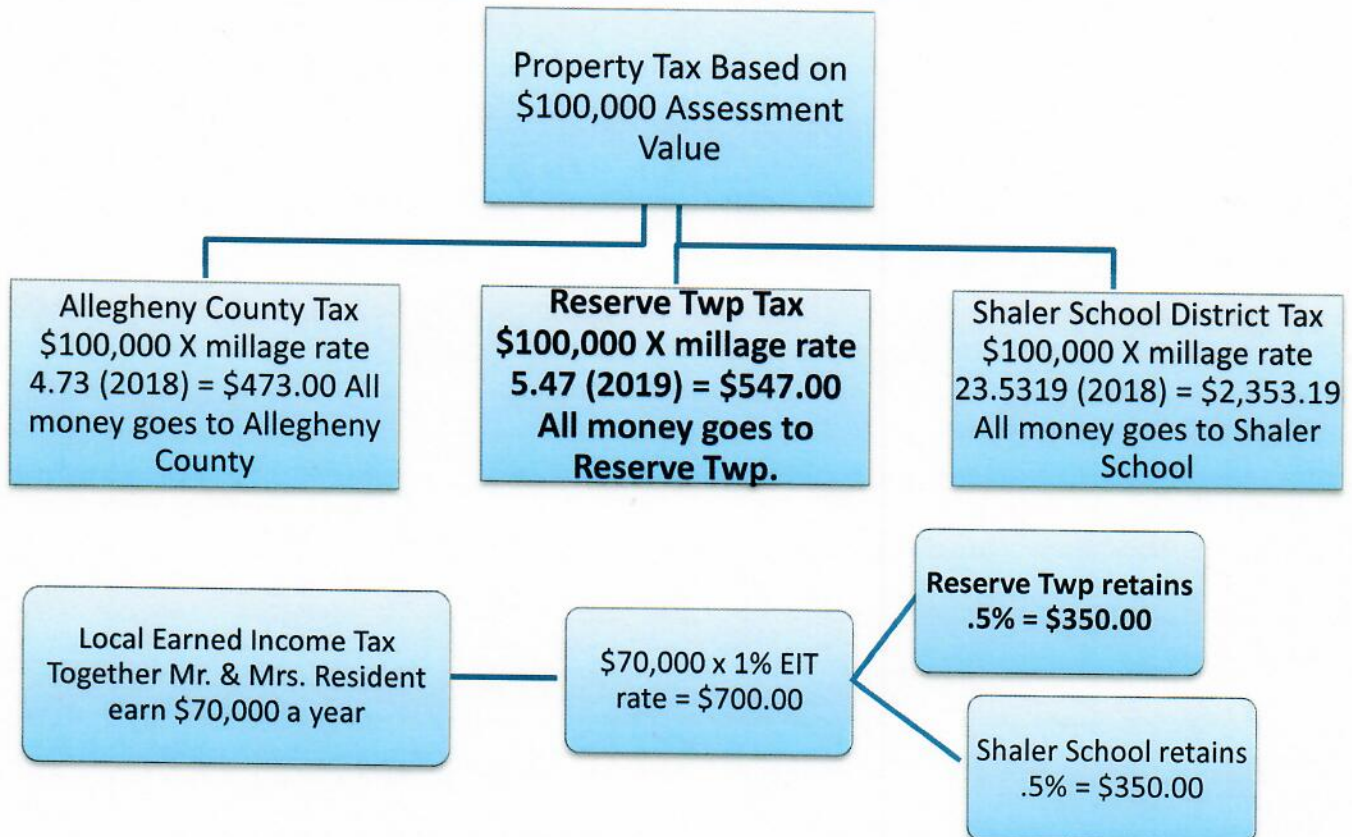
Example: Mr. & Mrs. Reserve Resident

Home is assessed for \$100,000.

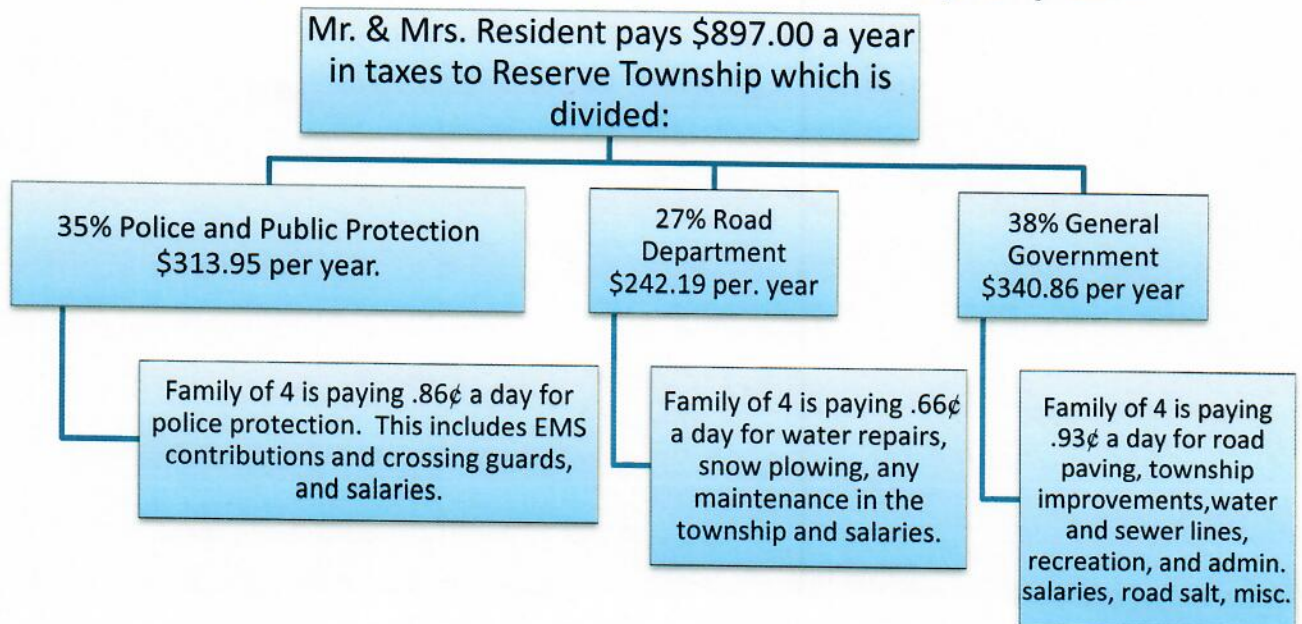
Mr. Resident works FT and earns \$50,000 a year

*** If you are 65 or older, you can qualify for a discount on your garbage and recycling service.**

Also,

*** Handicapped individuals and Senior citizens with no able-bodied individuals to assist them, can register for free "back yard" service.**

Physician verification required.

BOTH FORMS CAN BE OBTAINED IN THE TOWNSHIP OFFICE.

**Attention Landlords, Homeowners,
Managers and Tenants**

Reserve Township requires, by Ordinance, that all owners, landlords, managers and agents **MUST** register all tenants/renters from all properties located in Reserve Township. Forms are available at the Township Office.

During periods of high winds, please take an extra moment and make sure your recycling items and garbage containers



are secure to prevent trash from blowing into neighbors' yards, roadways, wooded areas, etc. Use garbage cans with a tight lid. If it is windy the night before trash collection, attempt to place the garbage containers out the morning of pick up.

GLASS RECYCLING
