

WINTER SNOW REMOVAL IN RESERVE TOWNSHIP

The Township's Public Works Division is responsible for clearing ALL the public roads in our community. We ask for your cooperation by **Keeping Your Vehicles Off The Streets And Cul-de-sacs**

During Snowfalls, especially those streets that have signs posted "No Parking, Snow Removal".

* Snow routes are completed according to priority, with main roads and school bus routes being cleared first. Side streets and secondary streets are cleared later. The Township Police notifies the Public Works of dangerous conditions which require immediate attention. If you have an emergency, call 911.

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES

- PARK YOUR VEHICLES IN YOUR DRIVEWAY
- IT IS AGAINST THE LAW TO SHOVEL SNOW ONTO ANY STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP. Police will enforce this law.
- USE CAUTION WHEN FOLLOWING SALT TRUCKS DURING SNOW REMOVAL.
- PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE TOWNSHIP OFFICE TO REPORT THAT YOUR STREET NEEDS TO BE PLOWED OR SALTED.

PREPARE FOR WINTER DRIVING

- * Snow tires are always recommended, they have deeper more flexible tread and are designed for snow covered roads.
- * check your wiper blades and replace if needed.
- * Make sure all vehicle lighting is working. headlights, brakes lights, turn signal, etc.

WINTER DRIVING TIPS

- *If heavy snow and ice are in the forecast, wait out the storm.
- * Completely remove all snow and ice from your vehicle to include the windshield, headlights, taillights, mirrors,
- *Avoid fast braking and increase the distance between vehicles.
- *Always keep a minimum of a half tank of fuel in your vehicle.

WINTER ESSENTIALS

- *A cellphone and charger
- * Jumper Cables
- * Blankets and extra clothing
- * Flashlight with extra batteries
- *Shovel

Trash & Recycling Service

- *All household trash must be in trash bags before being placed in the trash can. Loose garbage in cans will not be removed. Brush, branches, or tree limbs may not exceed 4 feet in length and material must be bundled.
- * Per Ordinance #495, no garbage, recyclable items, or other refuse materials are to be out for pickup earlier than 24 hours prior to normal scheduled pick up day.

- No Post-Dated checks will be accepted

NOTICE TO LANDLORDS AND TENANTS

As per Ordinance #513, no water bill will be put in tenants' names unless a billing change request form is filled out by the owners of the property, and an application for sewer and water service is completed and a \$200.00 security deposit is received. All forms can be found on the Township Website and in the Township office.

Note: This does not release the owners from delinquent bills. Owners are still responsible for any & all outstanding bills not paid by tenants.


Who do I call if I spot a pothole?

State Roads – Call PennDOT at 412-781-3260. (Geyer Rd, Lonsdale St, E. Beckert from Lonsdale to Thiel, Thiel, Mt. Troy Rd on the one way, Williams, Mt. Pleasant, Beech)

County Roads – Call 412-350-2513 (Hoffman Rd, Spring Garden Ave., Pittview Ave. from Troy Hill to Mt. Troy Rd. Mt. Troy Rd.
