

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK

Are you registered to receive water interruptions', Amber Alerts, or any other Emergency Notifications from the Township?

If not, we urge you to sign up for CODE RED Alerts at: <u>reservetwp.com.</u> Click Code Red System in the blue box on the left. MAKE SURE YOU SEND YOURSELF A TEST CALL. If you are registered and are not receiving calls, please re-register your number again. You will also have to re-register if your mobile provider changes. You can add multiple numbers on one address.

Attention Landlords, Homeowners, Managers and Tenants

Reserve Township requires, by Ordinance, that all owners, landlords, managers, and agents <u>MUST</u> register all tenants/renters from all properties located in Reserve township, along with an occupancy permit. Both must be completed before a tenant moves in. Forms are available on the township website or at the township office.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM POLICE CHIEF JIM ETHERINGTON

- **DO NOT BE A VICTIM!!!!** Remember to **Look**, **Light & Lock!** and remove valuables from unattended vehicles. **LOOK** for suspicious activity and report it immediately. **LIGHT** up the exterior of your home and always **LOCK your vehicle doors**.
- IF YOU HAVE AN EMERGENCY, CALL 911. DO NOT LEAVE A MESSAGE AT THE POLICE STATION. IF YOU NEED TO SPEAK TO A POLICE OFFICER ABOUT A SITUATION, CALL 911.
- The Township has received a growing number of complaints of neighbor's dogs being left out and barking for excessive amounts of time. Reserve Township Ordinance #673-18 prohibits any person to allow or control any animal or fowl which barks, bays, cries, squawks, crows, or makes any other such noise continuously and/or intermittently for an extended period which annoys or disturbs a reasonable person of normal sensitivities. Fines can reach as high as \$1,000.00. To avoid this is simple...BE COURTEOUS AND CONSIDERATE OF OTHERS!
- The Reserve Township Police Department will begin to aggressively enforce violations of our Environmental Impact Ordinance #583. This is a reminder advising all residents to cleanup and remove any rubbish, litter, yard debris, branches, clippings, tires, and other worthless trash from your property. Keep grass below (8) inches and cut/remove obnoxious vegetation. It is prohibited to keep or store any junk or abandoned vehicle on public or private property. An abandon or junk vehicle is defined as any vehicle that does not display a valid registration plate and valid inspection or has not been moved in (7) days.
- With the arrival of nice weather, it is a sure thing the Police Department will be receiving calls about recreational fires. Reserve Township follows Allegheny County Health Department's Open Burn Regulations. No material other than clean wood, propane or natural gas may be open burned EXCEPT for:
 - o Commercially available fire logs, paraffin logs or wood pellets.
 - o Paper or commercial smokeless fire starters to start a fire.
 - o Charcoal for the preparation of food only.

<u>Fires may be no larger than 3' wide by 3' long by 2' high.</u>

• When walking your dog in Reserve Township, remember that it must be leashed. Also, it is important to remember to immediately clean up after your pet. Take along a baggie with you to pick up waste with and then dispose of it properly.

2021 Real Estate Tax Collection

State Roads – **Call PennDOT at 412-781-3260**. (Geyer Rd, Lonsdale St, E. Beckert from Lonsdale to Thiel, Thiel, Mt. Troy Rd on the one way, Williams, Mt. Pleasant, Beech)

County Roads – Call 412-350-2513 (Hoffman Rd, Spring Garden Ave., Pittview Ave. from Troy Hill to Mt. Troy Rd. Mt. Troy Rd.)
