RESOLUTION NO. 750-22

A RESOLUTION OF RESERVE TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING AND SETTING NEWSANITARY SEWER RATES AND ESTABLISHING ANDSETTING NEW WATER RATES FOR RESERVE TOWNSHIP, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Reserve Township (hereinafter referred to as "the Township") has determined that an increase in the uniform charge for service is necessary to meet the actual and anticipated expenses of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township may fix, alter, charge and collect water rates and other charges in the area served by its facilities at reasonable and uniform rates to be determined exclusively by it, for the purpose of providing for the payment of the expenses of the Township, and the construction, improvement, repair, maintenance and operation of its potable water, sanitary and storm sewer facilities; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Reserve Township:

- 1. That effective with the January 1, 2023 Billing Cycle, the Water User Fee is raised to \$12.25 per 1,000 gallons of water
- 2. That effective with the January 1, 2023 Billing Cycle, the Sanitary User Fee is raised to \$13.21 per 1,000 gallons of water.
- 3. That effective with the January 1, 2023 Billing Cycle, the Quarterly Service Charge is raised to \$21.88 per Quarter which shall be charged to all sanitary sewer.
- 4. That effective with the January 1, 2023 Billing Cycle, the Quarterly Capital Improvement Charge remains at \$15.00 per Quarter which shall be charged to all water.
- 5. That effective with the January 1, 2023 Billing Cycle, the Quarterly minimum charge shall be \$148.72 for Alcosan users and \$164.72 for Girty's Run users, based on a minimum of 4,000 gallons of water.
- 6. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective January 1, 2023.
