

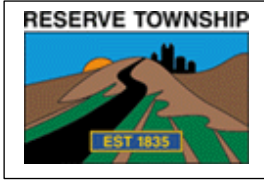

WELCOME SUMMER! IT'S POOL SEASON!

PLEASE KEEP IN THE MIND THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Please be advised that a **UCC Building Permit and Electrical Permit is required prior to the installation and/or construction of all above-ground swimming pools more than 24" deep and all in-ground swimming pools.** In-Ground (Residential or Public/Commercial) Swimming Pools require two inspections under the Uniform Construction Code. Above-Ground Swimming Pools: Please be advised that pools which are two to four feet in depth need to have a fence with a locking gate. Above ground pools over four feet do not require a fence however they must have removable ladder or a ladder that lifts and locks. An inspection is required once the pool is set up to verify that there is a safety barrier in place.

PLEASE CONTACT THE TOWNSHIP PRIOR TO POOL INSTALLATION FOR ALL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR POOL INSTALLATION.

PROPER POOL WATER DISCHARGE

When draining a swimming pool this year, make sure to protect Pennsylvania by following these tips:

- Pool water may be disposed of through the sanitary sewer system **ONLY** with township permission.
- Never dispose of pool water through a storm sewer, which will discharge to a stream.
- If lowering the water level of the pool, let it drain to a lawn to prevent it from running off into a storm sewer.
- If a sanitary sewer system is not available, water may be used for irrigation if it does not run off the property or into a storm sewer.

And don't forget: The discharge of swimming pool water to any waters of the commonwealth without a permit is a violation of the Clean Streams Law. Property owners and pool companies that violate this law may be prosecuted and penalized for damages. Don't let this happen to you!

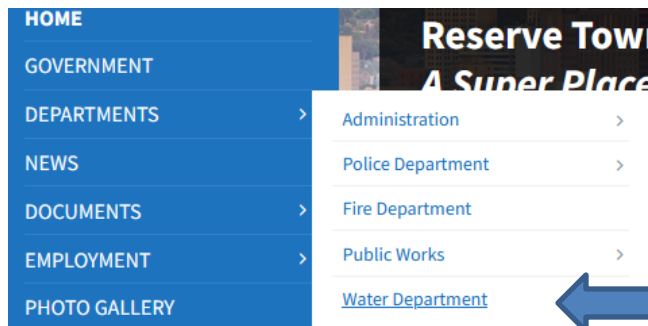

HYDRANT FLUSHING

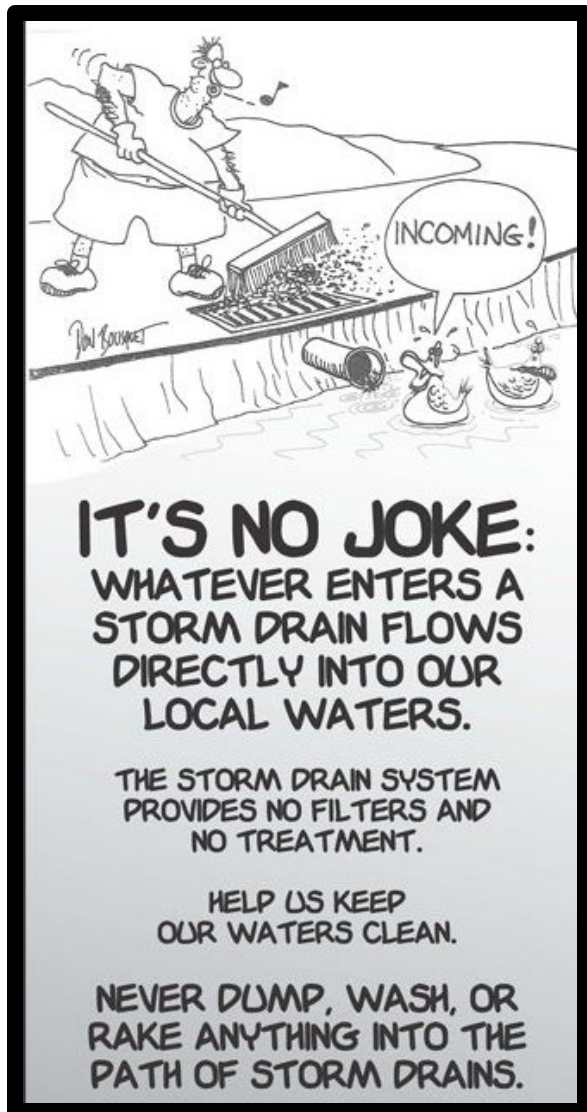

Please be sure to check your water before washing or other cleaning. If this should occur, run your water for a few minutes until the water becomes clear.

SUMMER STORMWATER

MANAGEMENT TIPS

- Know your grass! Different types of grasses require different methods of care. Cool-season grasses such as fescue, ryegrass and bluegrass should be mowed to 3 inches high. Warm-season grasses such as bermuda and zoysia should be mowed to 1-2 inches tall. The longer the grass, the stronger the root, which will help with stormwater runoff from your property.
- Leave grass clippings on the lawn because they hold in moisture and are rich in nitrogen, making them a natural fertilizer. Clean up lawn clippings that are on the street so they do not enter the storm drains- not cleaning grass clippings off street is a violation. Only fertilize in the fall, and only if it is needed. Sweep any excess fertilizer off driveways, walkways, roads, or any other impervious surface.
- Wash your car only when necessary and wash it over the grass rather than the driveway. The soil will serve as a natural filter to the soaps, chemicals, break dust and any leaking liquids from your car.
- Don't feed the geese and ducks - particularly around lakes and ponds. Lakes are vital to stormwater management and pet/duck waste, like fertilizers, pollute the water, causing algae blooms that rob the lake of oxygen and kill fish and other aquatic life.
- Scoop the poop! Be sure to pick up after your dog. Their waste is not natural - it is full of bacteria and excess nutrients that will create algae blooms and contaminate local waterways.
