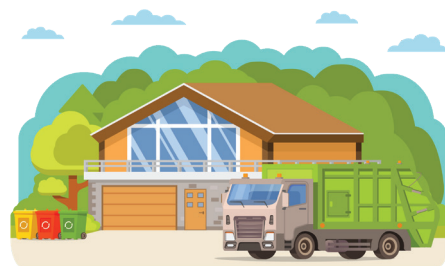
COUNTY HAULING CURBSIDE E-WASTE RECYCLING COLLECTION

ARE YOU SELLING YOUR HOME? DO YOU HAVE A NEW TENANT MOVING IN?

Here are the things that you will need to have completed before selling your home:

- Occupancy Certificate, call the Township Office and schedule an appointment with our Code Enforcement Officer
- Dye test, completed by a certified plumber
- Municipal Lien Letter
- Final Read will be completed 2 days before closing.

A Property Registration form will need to be completed for all new Tenants.

WHAT'S HAPPENING ON MT. TROY ROAD?

For the next year and a half, you will notice truck activity coming and going from the site. As long-time residents may know, in 2010 the Township purchased a piece of property on Mt. Troy Road, between Most Holy Name Cemetery and Ross/ West View EMS Station. The plan at that time was to one day build a new municipal complex on the site. We experienced some complications with demolition of the existing structures and the development plans were put on hold. In the meantime, the site just sat vacant and, frankly, didn't look very attractive.

Fast forward to 2023, and the Township was offered a unique opportunity to develop the site at no cost to taxpayers. A local construction contractor will be depositing clean fill, grading the property, and installing a fence. Once the project is complete, the Commissioners will be considering possible uses to benefit Township residents.
