- Pizza box lids – If not tainted by food
- Boxboard: such as tissue, dry food boxes, cereal, noodles and cake boxes

Put all non-recyclable material in the trash



## Non-Recyclable

- Types 3-7 Plastic
- Garbage, food waste, diapers, paper plates, hangers, old plastic toys
- Meat or dairy plastic or Z paper packaging
- Wax or plastic wrap or bags
- Freezer food packaging
- Plastic deli, product or take-out packaging or utensils
- Plastic bags or wrapping film
- Formed or pellet Styrofoam packaging

Here are the things that you will need to have completed before selling your home:

- Occupancy Certificate, call the Township Office and schedule an appointment with our Code Enforcement Officer
- Dye test, completed by a certified plumber
- Municipal Lien Letter
- Final Read will be completed 2 days before closing.

A Property Registration form will need to be completed for all new Tenants.
