- Occupancy Certificate, call the Township Office and schedule an appointment with our Code Enforcement Officer
- Dye test, completed by a certified plumber
- Municipal Lien Letter
- Final Read will be completed 2 days before closing.

A Property Registration form will need to be completed for all new Tenants.

UPDATE ON PWSA WATER AGREEMENT

SINCE THE TOWNSHIP IS STILL WAITING ON APPROVAL FROM THE PUC REGARDING THE 0&M AGREEMENT WITH PWSA, THE TOWNSHIP WILL CONTINUE TO GENERATE THE QUARTERLY WATER BILLS FOR NOW. THE BOARD PASSED RESOLUTION #771 TO INCREASE THE RATES, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2024, ON AVERAGE 8% TO PASS THROUGH THE INCREASE OF COSTS CHARGED TO THE TOWNSHIP BY ALCOLSAN AND PWSA.
