ORDINANCE NO. 705

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RESERVE AMENDING CHAPTER 94, POLICE DEPARTMENT, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REPEALING SECTIONS 94-2 AND 94-4 RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION ON HIRING PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS.

WHEREAS, the Township of Reserve, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania (the "Township") employs a professional Police Department, for the purpose of responding to emergencies and enforcing federal, state, and local laws; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 94 of the Code of Ordinances of the Township establishes the hiring procedure for police officers with the Township of Reserve Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Township has determined that the employment of part-time police officers alongside full-time police officers in the Township Police Department provides for additional manpower, eliminates lapses in police protection, allows for greater scheduling flexibility, and reduces costs; and

WHEREAS, the Township, through its Board of Commissioners, has determined that the interests of the Township and the health, safety, and welfare of its residents will be best served by allowing the Township of Reserve Police Department to supplement its manpower through the utilization of part-time police officers in addition to full-time officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners hereby ordains that the Reserve Township Code of Ordinances be amended, as follows:

I. The Reserve Township Code of Ordinances shall be amended by repealing and deleting Section 94-2, Township Hiring Requirements, and Section 94-4, Repeal of Documentation for Use of Part-Time Police Officers, in their entirety, and renumbering the remaining sections of the chapter in their current order.

II. Should any part or portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intention of the Board of Commissioners that all remaining parts and portions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect to the full extent permitted by law.

III. Any ordinance or resolution inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


IV. This Ordinance shall be effective as of the date of adoption by the Board of Commissioners.


